

Email Use Policy - CIPHI Alberta Branch

Use of email by the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) Alberta Branch Executive and associated committees is permitted and encouraged where such use supports the goals and objectives of the Branch.

CIPHI Alberta Branch has a policy for the use of email whereby the users must ensure that they:

- comply with current legislation
- use email in an acceptable way
- do not create unnecessary business risk to the Branch by their misuse of the internet

CIPHI Alberta Branch accepts that the use of email is a valuable business tool. However, misuse of this facility can have a negative impact upon the reputation of the Branch.

Where it is believed that an email user has failed to comply with this policy, the branch can choose to suspend use of the account.

It is important to note, all email addresses are owned by CIPHI Alberta Branch and not the individual users. The account, and all emails contained within it, will be passed along to an eventual successor.
